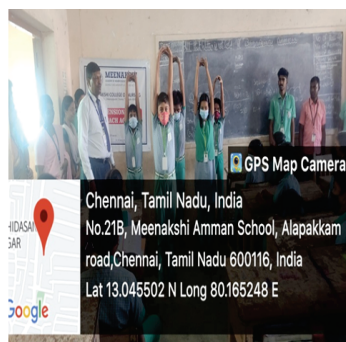

RESEARCH PROJECTS

The following research projects, clinical trials, endowments, and chairs have been undertaken by various principal investigators and co-investigators in different departments:

"Effect Of Occlusal Reduction On Postoperative Pain Following Single Visit Endodontic Treatment On Posterior Teeth - A Randomized Controlled Trial" led by Dr. Suma Ballal from the Department of Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital, Chennai. The project, funded by Mark Air-Particulate Control Systems, aims to investigate the impact of occlusal reduction on postoperative pain after endodontic treatment.

"Influence Of Integrated Yoga Program On Testosterone Among Girls Diagnosed With PCOS" conducted by Dr. V. Subbulakshmi from the Faculty of Yoga Science and Therapy. The project, funded by Easy Yoga Studioz, focuses on studying the effects of an integrated yoga program on testosterone levels in girls diagnosed with polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS).

"Effect Of Yoga Therapy With And Without Kalari On Selected Risk Factors Among Adolescent School Obese Girls" led by Dr. Anitha Harry from Meenakshi Medical College Hospital and Research Institute. The project, funded by Narchinthanai Vattam Charitable Trust, aims to evaluate the impact of yoga therapy with and without Kalari (a traditional martial art form) on various risk factors in obese adolescent girls.

"Isolation And Identification Of Microflora In Periodontitis By Microbiological And Biochemical Methods" conducted by Dr. B. Kavitha from Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital. The project, supported by Mark Air-Particulate Control Systems, focuses on isolating and identifying microflora associated with periodontitis using microbiological and biochemical techniques.

"In Vitro Antibacterial Efficacy Of Fruit Juice Extracts On Cariogenic Micro-Organisms" led by Dr. J. Mohammed Farzan from Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital. The project, funded by Genetika, aims to assess the antibacterial effectiveness of fruit juice extracts against cariogenic microorganisms in vitro.

"Comparison Of Stress Distribution In Two Plate And Four Plate Fixation Following Le-Fort I Advancement Using Finite Element Analysis" undertaken by Dr. T. Srinivasa Prasad from Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital, with support from Genetika. This project involves utilizing finite element analysis to compare stress distribution in two-plate and four-plate fixation methods after Le-Fort I advancement surgery.

"Effect Of Yogic Practices With And Without Psychoneurobics On Selected Risk Factors Among Down Syndrome Boys" conducted by Dr. N. Muninathan from Meenakshi Medical College Hospital and Research Institute. The project, funded by Yes Fit Studio, focuses on evaluating the impact of yogic practices, with and without psychoneurobics, on various risk factors in boys with Down syndrome.

"Effect Of Yogic Practices With And Without Mantra Chanting On Selected Risk Factors Among Menopausal Women" led by Dr. R. Muthulakshmi from Meenakshi Medical College Hospital and Research Institute. This project, supported by Padmam Yoga, aims to examine the effects of yogic practices, with and without mantra chanting, on specific risk factors experienced by menopausal women.

"Effect Of Yogic Practices With And Without Diet On Selected Risk Factors Among Middle-Aged Women Suffering From Insomnia" undertaken by Dr. Rajasekar from Meenakshi Medical College Hospital and Research Institute, with funding from Padmam Yoga. The project aims to explore the impact of yogic

SOFT SKILL PROGRAMS

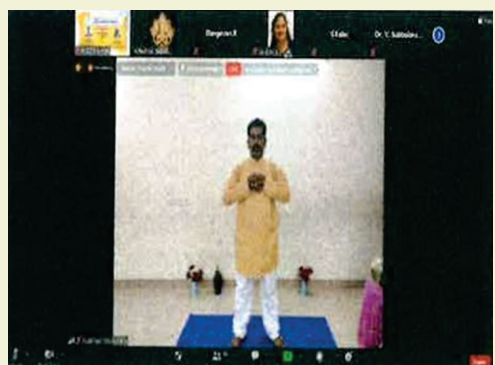
