Senior educationist and Chancellor of Meenakshi Academy of Higher Education and Research (Deemed to be University) --MAHER -- Thiru. A N Radhakrishnan passed away on 04.12.22 after a brief illness.

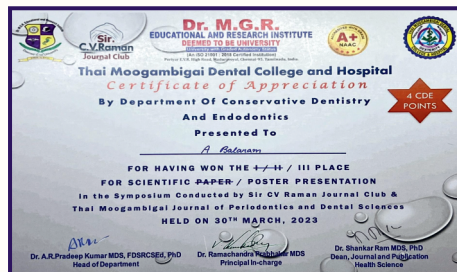

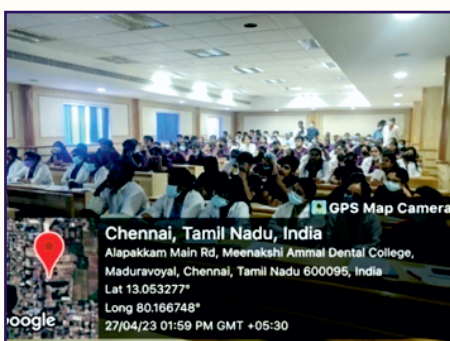
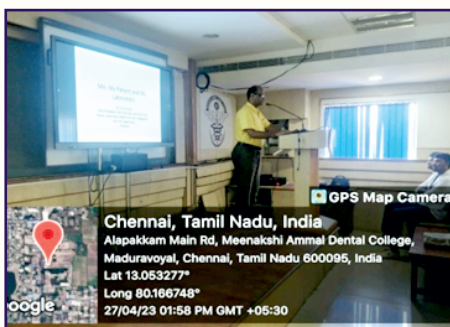


GUEST LECTURES DELIVERED

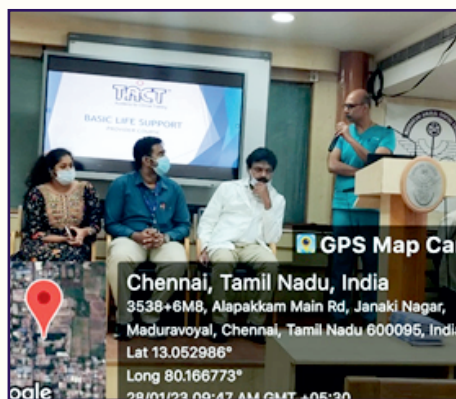

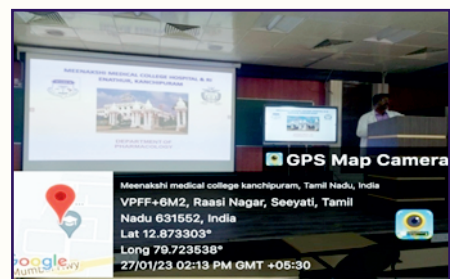
CYBER CRIME AWARENESS PROGRAM

CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM was conducted by Department of OBG in association with Department of Pathology on 08.03.2023



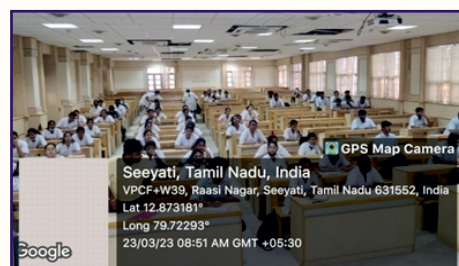
