RESEARCH PROJECTS

Various departments within Meenakshi Medical College Hospital and Research Institute, Meenakshi Ammal Dental College and Hospital, Faculty of Nursing, Faculty of Yoga Science and Therapy, and Faculty of Physiotherapy have undertaken projects funded by organizations like Mashirr Systems, Muthukumaran Trust, Synergy Scientific Services, Biologix, and Genetika. The projects are led by different principal investigators and co-investigators, focusing on areas like molecular biomarkers, surgical anatomy, stress evaluation, effectiveness of interventions, genetic factors, bone health, and rehabilitation. Their research aims to contribute to the understanding and improvement of healthcare in diverse fields, advancing knowledge and benefiting patients in their respective areas of study.

VALUE ADDED COURSES

6 Physiotherapy Camps on Posture Awareness were conducted by FPT in various residential areas in and around Chennai.










NEW EQUIPMENTS






Faculty Induction Programs


National Deworming Day Programme






Events Organised




