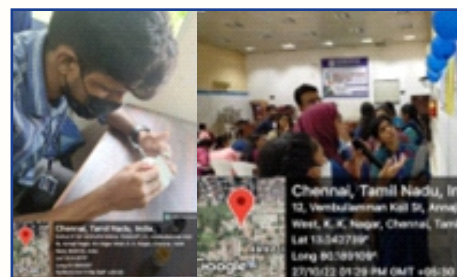
#### 1) DIWALI CELEBRATION

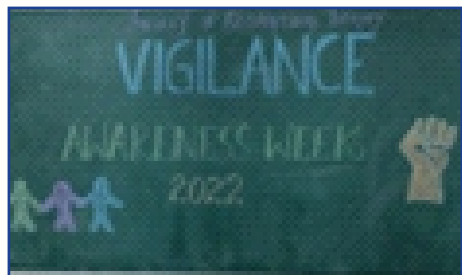


#### 3) VIGILANCE WEEK 2022

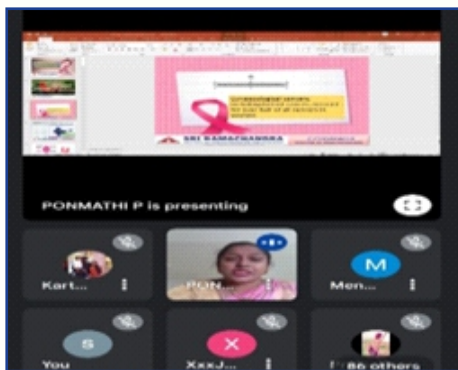
