WHAT: This HIV Testing and Counselling Training (HTCT) certification course is meant for the professionals in the healthcare settings including blood bank. This course provides training on pre and post-test counselling, HIV-testing (as per the NABL-112), occupational post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP), legal and ethical issues related to the HIV testing.

WHOM: Professionals from hospitals, diagnostic laboratories and blood banks which are National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL), ISO 15189: 2022 and National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH) accredited or under preparation for accreditation can participate:

- **Diagnostic laboratory professionals (Pathologists, Microbiologists, Biochemists, Quality Managers).**
- **Medical Officers and other staff in health-care settings.**

WHEN: Online 2-day (1.30 PM – 5.30 PM) virtual program on 15th & 16th May 2025.

HOW: Lectures, case studies and interactive sessions. Professionals including laboratory experts, clinicians, scientists with years of HIV/AIDS training experience will facilitate the program.

Importantly, it is a gateway to prevention, care, treatment and support.

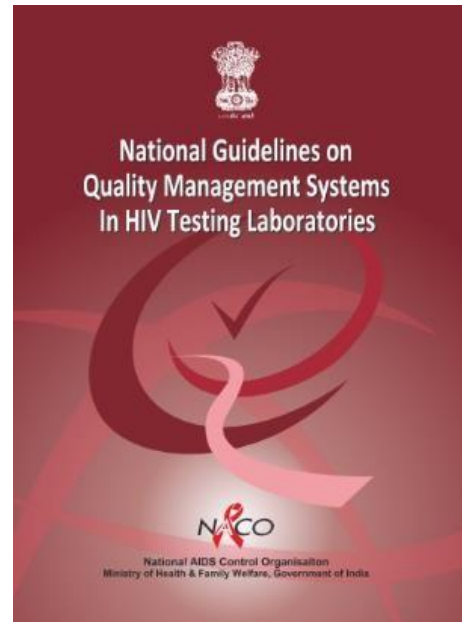
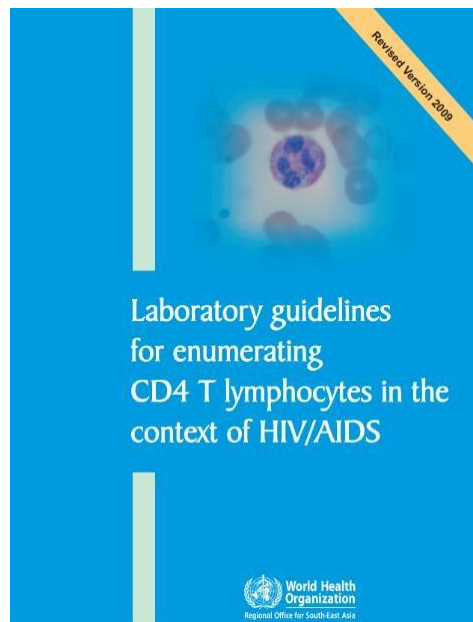
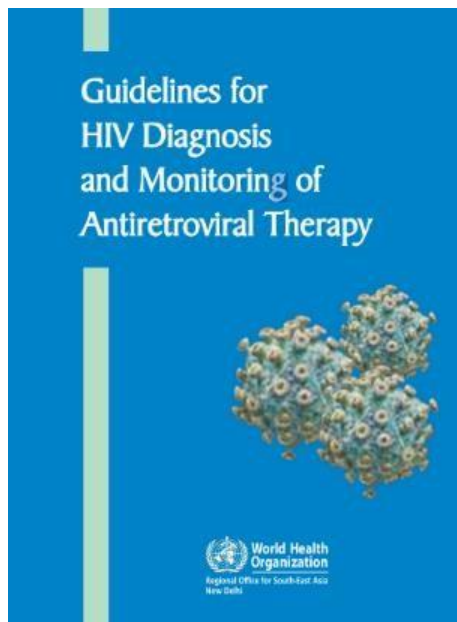
As per the **National AIDS Control Organization (NACO), Government of India, New Delhi** the health care settings should offer a service to protect an individual and their families by practicing the “5 Cs - Consent, Confidentiality, Counselling, Correct test results and Connection)”. This **HIV Testing and Counselling Training (HTCT)** program consists of 5 core components: 1. Pre-test counselling that outlines the testing process 2. A risk-behavior assessment 3. Informed consent of each participant 4. Administration of the HIV test 5. Post-test counselling based on the test result(s). This is also implemented through the standards and guidelines of the **NABL** and **NABH** in public and private health care settings.
